Circle & Conferencing are alternative dispute resolution strategies that are effective in involving participants experiencing conflict in a community-oriented and values-driven approach to exploring issues, gaining insight into shared and diverse perspectives, building understanding, problem solving, and healing rifts that may have emerged as a result of conflict(s). There is a role in these processes for those who are primarily impacted by the conflict as well as those who have been indirectly impacted by the conflict. Common Worth offers the following services related to Circle & Conferencing: conflict assessment; participant values exploration; circle/conference design; circle keeping/conference facilitation; and balanced documentation.
